Recreation Commission Meeting

January 12, 2016

Present: Vicki Donlan, Mark Thorell, Sarah Melia, Bruce Thompson and Adrienne Ramsey.

1. The meeting was brought to order at 6:33 PM by the chair.
2. A motion to accept the December meeting minutes with edits was made by Bruce Thompson, seconded by Adrienne Ramsey and unanimously approved.
3. Skate House: Work is complete, and the facility is prepared to open once weather permits. Mark received approval from Michael Clancy, the Building Commissioner, to open the East Street skate house. Mark made the Capital Outlay committee aware of the future renovations needed to the building at the meeting on Monday, January 11th.
4. Rec Barn: The board of selectmen voted to approve the final construction construct. The contractor will start the renovation by the end of January.
5. Fitness: There are now 558 active members of the fitness room. A new spin instructor was hired, and the department is still looking for new instructors. A proposal has been sent to a Taekwondo company for the 2016-2017 season.
6. Summer Program: Registration will open February 1st for summer camp. Applications for employment at summer camp will be due on February 15th.
7. Town Pool: An RFP has been issued for the management of the Town Pool. The award will be announced by the end of February. The recreation department has submitted a proposal in 2015, but it does not meet the requirements of the minimum of five years of pool management.
8. Kress Field/PARC Grant: CPC will vote this Wednesday evening on the Kress Playground.
9. Recreation Commission Town Report: The commission reviewed the draft town report presented by the director.
10. A motion to adjourn was made by Bruce Thompson, seconded by Sarah Melia and was unanimously approved. The meeting adjourned at 8:13 PM.
