1. The meeting was brought to order at 6:30 PM by the chair.
2. A motion to accept the January meeting minutes with edits was made by Bruce Thompson, seconded by Adrienne Ramsey and unanimously approved.
3. Fitness Room: There are currently 582 active members. The promotion of free membership helped the room reach its goal of 500 members.
4. Taekwondo: There will be a 60/40 split in terms of revenue sharing. The classes will also have a once a week option. A beginner's class will be offered this spring, and the year round option will start in September
5. Kress Field: CPC voted unanimously for funding Kress Field. It will be voted at advisory next Tuesday and at the Selectmen's meeting next Thursday.
6. Future Programming: Mark is meeting with a teacher proposing a toddler dance/movement class. He will investigate adding more adult fitness classes in the evening once the Rec Barn is open.
7. Summer programs: There have been over 200 sign-ups for summer camp after registration opened yesterday. The graphic designer is working on the draft of the spring and summer brochure. It is scheduled to be mailed the first week of March.
8. Revolving Fund: The commission reviewed the revenue from operations for the second quarter.
9. A new summer administrator was hired.
10. Facilities and fields: The Building Commissioner has approved the opening of the East Skate House for the 2016 season. One irrigation zone will be added to Margetts Field. Powers and Kress infields will be edged and groomed.
11. A motion to adjourn was made by Bruce Thompson, seconded by Budd Thorne and was unanimously approved. The meeting adjourned at 7:36 PM.
