1. Call to order: 7:39pm
2. Open Issues (Recurring matters):
 - a. Town Wharf Projects: according to Town Engineer Frey, it is anticipated the Woods Hole Group will be in a position to provide a report within weeks. The Committee agreed to seek a meeting with Woods Hole Group on May 25 to discuss status and, further out, seek to meet with the Conservation Commission to present findings.
 - b. Bathing Beach season update: the Beach House restaurant is officially open. Other updates include the upcoming installation of trees, solar lighting and signage.
 - c. Route 3A Task Force update: Deirdre Anderson provided an update on the most recent discussion, noting key topics included: when to present the 25% status update to the public, considerations for lighting locations (including some resistance by Summer Street residents to potential land takings for power pole relocations) , utility lines under the rotary and potential options for additional public works support for maintaining the new vegetation and trees that will be planted.
 - d. CPC Grant Request for 'Harbor Vision Study': Marco Boer agreed to run point on the process for the Committee.
 - e. MAPC Stakeholder Meeting #6, May 5, 2021: the final MAPC report was circulated prior to meeting and Committee members will review and provide comments to Josh Fiala, the MAPC project leader.
 - f. Harbormaster matters: no significant update.
