Dear Conservation Commission,


We are requesting permission to start a landscaping project on our property that abuts wetlands next to the Weir River. We are working with Patricia Van Buskirk of PVLA. Our plans include relocating a garden shed that is within the 100' boundary of the resource area. The shed will be moved to our backyard, well outside the boundary of the resource area. We will remove an invasive species (Japanese knotweed) that is currently within the 50' buffer. Plantings within the 50' buffer are primarily a line of inkberry bushes, supplemented with some winterberry holly, summersweet and a couple of leucothoe. Within the 100' boundary, the following native species will be used:

Native plantings include:

- Winterberry Holly Red Sprite
- Swamp Azalea
- Shadblow
- Juniperus Virginiana
- Cherry Laurel

All planned hardscape work is outside of the 100' buffer for the wetlands. Please see the enclosed project plans for further details.
