All essential service workers must wear protective face coverings when interacting with the public and when within 6 ft. of a coworker

Effective Sunday, April 19, 2020 @ 12:01am

- 1. All essential workers must wear protective face coverings when interacting with the public and when they are within 6 ft. of coworkers. This order applies to employees in all grocery stores, restaurants, pharmacies, and all essential businesses included in Governor Baker's COVID-19 Essential Services Order. - 2. Cloth face coverings should:
  - Fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
  - Be secured with ties and/or ear loops
  - Include multiple layers of fabric
  - Allow for breathing without restriction
  - Be able to be laundered and machine dried without damage or change in shape

- 3. Do not use medical masks, such as the N95 masks those should be reserved for health care workers and first responders.
- 4. All businesses must enforce social distancing of 6 ft. between members of the public in their establishments. Businesses shall post signage on the door advising on social distancing.
- 5. For essential workers who do not wear cloth face coverings when interacting with the public or within 6 ft. of coworkers, the fine will be \$50 for a first offense, \$150 for a second offense, and \$300 for a third offense and possible closure of your business by the Hingham Board of Health.
